

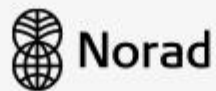

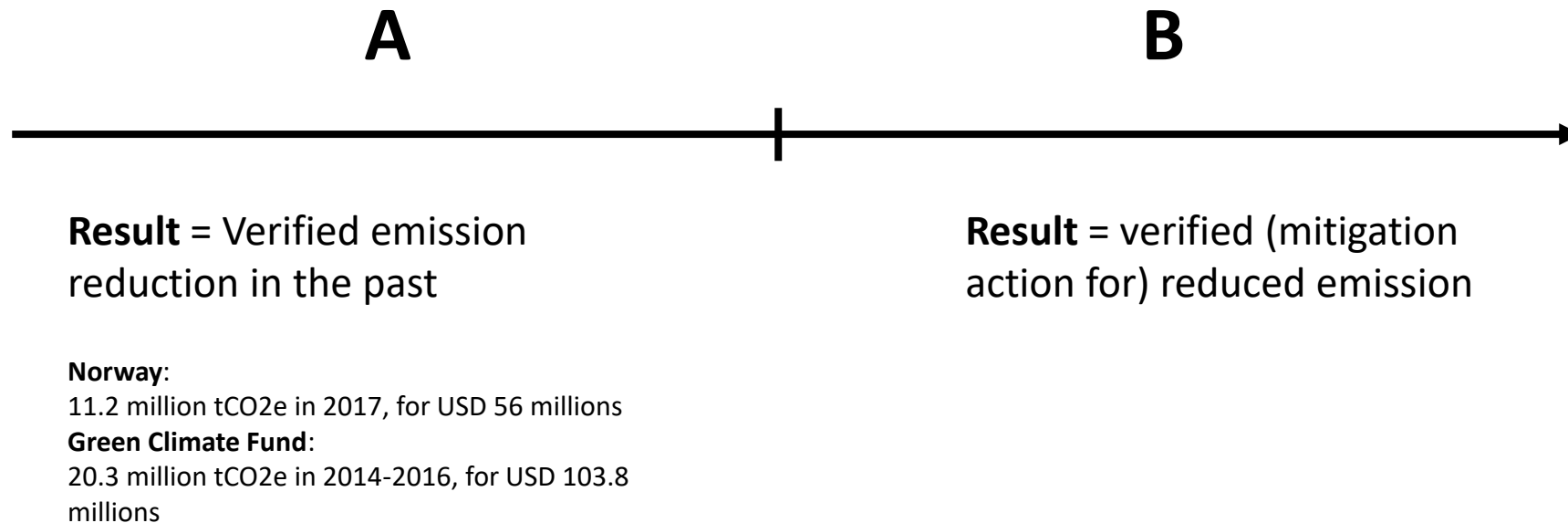

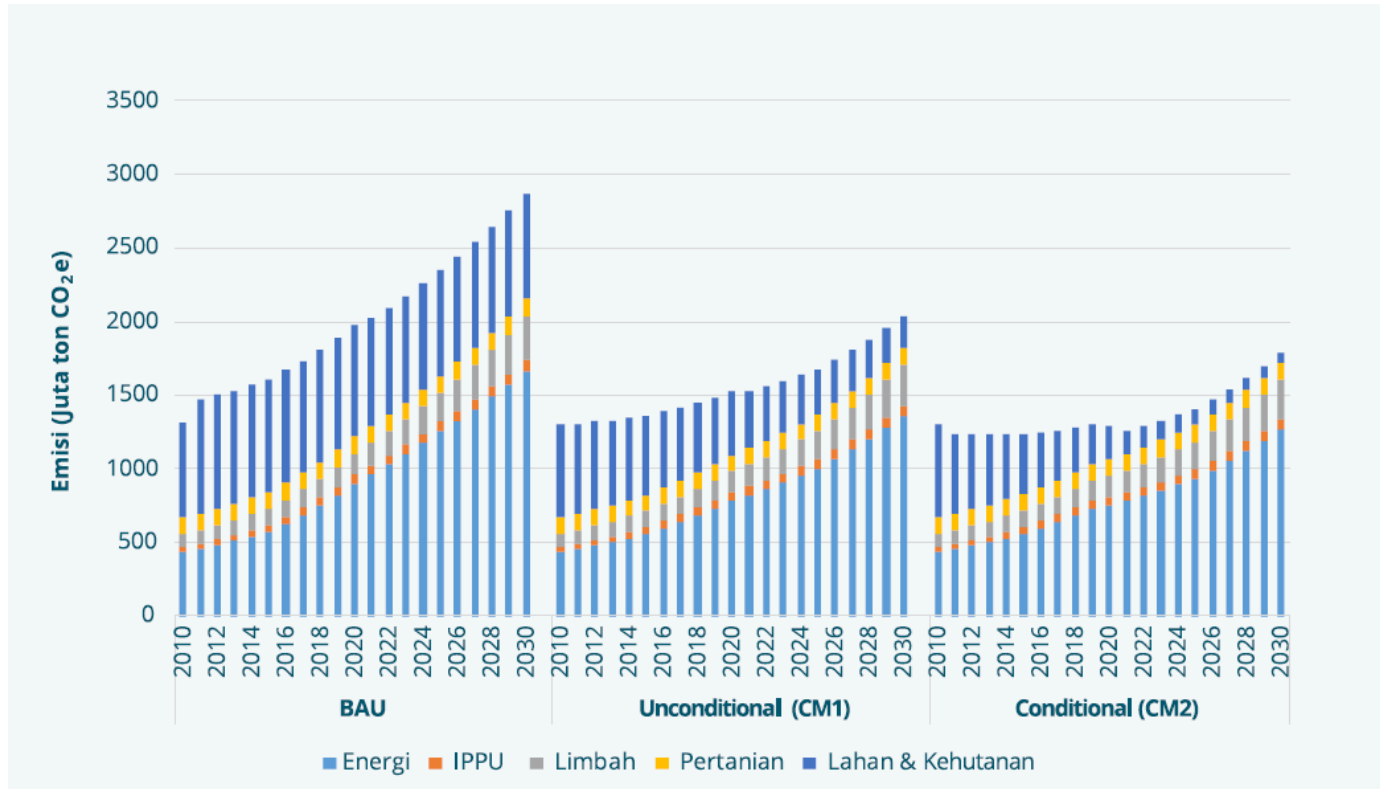
Outcome

NDC Roadmap:

Mitigation actions for Agriculture, Land and Forestry Sector

1. Reducing deforestation and forest degradation

Planned and un-planned reduction of deforestation and forest degradation of natural forest

2. Sustainable Forest Management

Reduced impact logging; sustainable forestry

3. Increasing Carbon Stock

Plantation forest on mineral and peatland; forest enhancement and rehabilitation

4. Increasing the role of conservation

5. Peatland management
