

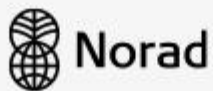

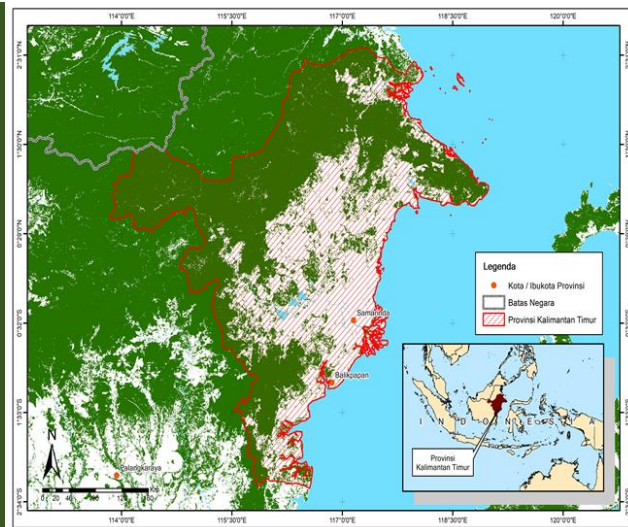

## CIFOR – DEWAN DAERAH PERUBAHAN IKLIM (DDPI) STUDY

- DDPI is a multi stakeholder platform aimed for coordinating climate change related activities and programs in East Kalimantan, including the FCPF-Carbon fund
- Developed a tool that enables participatory reflective monitoring in multi-stakeholder forums (MSFs).
- Through monitoring tool workshop, we developed indicators that fit with the DDPI context and can help monitor the MSF process especially for FCPF carbon fund program



## DEWAN DAERAH PERUBAHAN IKLIM (DDPI)

- ❑ DDPI led the coordination of CC programs in EK, mainstreaming CC mitigation strategies and green development into government programs, strategic planning document and medium-term regional development plans
- ❑ DDPI has brought together various stakeholders and facilitated the collaboration process among stakeholders which allow them to exchange different view
- ❑ In 2015, the MoEF has designated East Kalimantan Province as pilot for FCPF program. The Governor has assigned DDPI for coordinating and preparing the activities.
- ❑ In the last 5 years, DDPI has led coordination between Provincial and the MoEF teams in improving REDD + Readiness in East Kalimantan. The implementation of FCPF will be started after the ERPA was signed



## MONITORING TOOL FOR MSF TO SUPPORT FCPF PROGRAM

- ❑ The tool is useful for self-evaluation, increase the effectiveness and enrich the outcome and actions of MSF
- ❑ The tool will help DDPI for implementing the FCPF program:
  - (a) increase stakeholder's understanding on the objectives of FCPF program
  - (b) understanding each party's roles in achieving target activity
  - (c) increase collaboration between parties effectively
  - (d) broaden stakeholder involvement including local communities and women
